The strip of land is bounded by Coomera Road to the east, Southport Road to the west and Normanby Road and Hatton Drive to the north. This road was named after the famous gentleman's race between England and Australia which was held in 1877 at the location known as the Polo Ground. The success of the race prompted the development of the polo club which later expanded into a racecourse. This track was one of the first in Australia, and despite claims that it was a natural, the first race was scheduled and was the only one ever run on the property. The club continued to host racing until 1933, when the land was acquired by Gold Coast Council. Geography The neighbourhood is bounded by several residential areas including Nanamah, Nanamah Hills, Curlewis, Jambi, Nanuet, Chanter House, Templeton and Nanuet which are located on the land bounded by Coomera Road to the east, Southport Road to the west and Normanby Road and Hatton Drive to the north.
